

PASS

"Plan to Achieve Self-Support"

- an incentive to allow a person with a disability to work & still receive SSI benefits
- by writing a PASS plan, certain expenses needed to obtain & keep a job MAY be excluded from countable income for a person receiving SSI.

**If you get SSI benefits,
and need help to maintain your job, a PASS plan
will allow you to get the help you need.**

Local agencies have people trained to help you write a **PASS**.
