

What Will Happen at my IEP Meeting?

The Team Will:

- Review past IEP's and your transition needs and plan, if you have one.
- Look at new evaluations from Doctors, Therapists, and/or School Representatives.
- Review your Personal Plans for the future.
- Decide what you will need to do while you are in school to help you be the most prepared for your future.
(These needs will help in developing your IEP Annual goals)
- Decide how you will do these things and who you will need to help you.
- For each GOAL, your Team will decide what steps you will take to accomplish your Goals (these are your IEP objectives or Benchmarks) *

You should include every part of your life in the Future:

- Will you go to school after high school?
- Where will you work?
- What will you do for friends and fun?
- Where will you live?
- Can you take care of yourself?

When the meeting ends, you and your team should know:

- Where you are going?
- How you will get there?
- What help you will need and can expect to get?

Everyone has ideas to help, but **YOU** should be the main person to decide! It is **YOUR** life!!!
